Atlantic Stage, working under an SPT1 Agreement with Actors' Equity Association, announces one full day of Equity auditions for *Bigfoot and other Lost Souls*, the next production of its 2011-2012 season.

Auditions will be held on Friday, December 16th from 9 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. – 5 p.m. at the 79th Avenue Theatre in the Coastal Carolina University Myrtle Beach Education Center, 900 79th Ave N, Myrtle Beach SC 29572.

Show and roles being cast are:

- *Bigfoot and other Lost Souls* by Adrien Royce and Mark Hollmann, directed by John Woodson. First rehearsal date: Tuesday, December 27th. Performance dates: Jan. 26th (preview)-Jan. 28th at 7:30 p.m., Jan. 29th at 3 p.m., Feb. 2nd-Feb. 4th at 7:30 p.m., Feb. 5th at 3:00 p.m., Feb. 9th-Feb. 11th at 7:30 p.m., and Feb. 12th at 3:00 p.m.
 - This new musical comedy-fable follows a young woman who lost her baby – when she didn't even know she had one. Bernie accepts an assignment to write a documentary about Bigfoot and, while encountering a slew of tabloid-sized characters, discovers the truth not only about the creature but also herself.

Non-Equity performers may attend and wait for an open slot. They will be seen when no Equity member is auditioning or waiting to audition.

All performers should prepare two contrasting songs (16 bars each; one ballad, one up-tempo) and a comic monologue. The entire package should total no more than 4 minutes in length. An accompanist will be provided.
